/ **Sharing ideas and discussing** during regular meetings with various public, non-for-profit and private decision-makers, to make aware and identify key matters to be addressed.

/ **Raising awareness and mobilizing for action**, by sharing news about climate and weather, and making them accessible to everyone through events and digital communication actions.

/ **Identifying and collecting data and information on climate and weather**, popularizing scientific studies and providing images and awareness-raising tools, especially to journalists, weathercasters and teachers from all over the world.

/ **Communicating throughout the year** to actively contribute to the mobilization of citizens: events, blogs, videos, photo campaigns, infographics relayed on social networks...
