#### A 3-DAY PROGRAM

Strongly supported by the World Meteorological Organization, the IPCC, the Italian Meteorological Society and other European and Italian partners, the workshop "Communicating on Climate Change" created and strengthen relationship between professional of the media, the scientific community and corporate players.

The workshop 2017 in Turin proposed a 3-day program:

#### March 30<sup>th</sup> Discussion Groups

After a presentation on the "**Perception of climate change**" the first day has been dedicated to Discussion Groups, where the participants (~ 20 per groups) have discussed 4 different topics: "**Communicating extreme weather events**", "**Global warming and sea level rise**", "**Climate change and developing countries**", "**International conferences and agreements**". At the end of the day, the rapporteurs have presented to the audience a synthesis of the discussions highlighting the main outcomes of the discussions.

#### March 31<sup>th</sup> Presentations & Roundtables

The second day has been inaugurated by a video greetings of Hoesung Lee, chair of the IPCC. The full day featured presentations, roundtables and an interactive workshop on topics such as **communication constraints** on climate change in the media, future **climate projections** and their **impacts on the cities and countries**, the contribution of the climate service **Copernicus** for the media, **attribution of extreme weather events** to climate change...

#### April 1<sup>st</sup> Excursion to the Ag

#### Excursion to the Agenzia di Pollenzo (Slow Food)

A special conference has been prepared for the participants of the IWF2017 at the University of Gastronomic Sciences at the Agenzia of Pollenzo (60 km from Turin), one of the presidia of the international movement SLOW FOOD for the protection of food biodiversity, to highlight the link between food and climate change.


